Operations for RTD's G Line were originally scheduled to commence in late 2016. Though the commencement of operations was continually delayed due several external factors, the G Line opening day has been set for April 26, 2019.

As a token of RTD's commitment to its community partners, stakeholders, and constituents, the resolution expresses the Board's strong support for a proposal to offer free service for travel on the G Line for the first two full weeks of service operations, commencing Sunday, April 28, 2019, and ending Saturday, May 11, 2019.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**


The financial impact of this resolution falls within the General Manager's discretionary authority, and any necessary adjustments will be included in the 2019 Amended Budget.
