**RESOLUTION NO. 005, SERIES OF 2019
(RTD Board's Support for Two Weeks of
Free Service for G Line Travel)**

WHEREAS, The G Line, the 11.2-mile western arm of RTD's expansive Eagle P3 commuter rail project, runs from Denver Union Station through Denver, Adams, and Jefferson Counties, terminating at Wheat Ridge/Ward Station; and

WHEREAS, G Line operations were originally scheduled to commence in late 2016; and

WHEREAS, Due to several external factors, the commencement of operations was continually delayed, and the constituents and businesses along the corridor have been patiently awaiting the line's opening since that time; and


WHEREAS, General Manager Genova announced on April 1, 2019, that the G Line will finally go into operation on April 26, 2019; and

WHEREAS, The RTD Board recognizes that the delay in G Line operations has caused significant inconvenience and frustration for those who have long anticipated its opening; and


WHEREAS, As an acknowledgment of the impacts endured by those along the corridor due to lack of promised service and inconvenience while waiting, and as a gesture of the good will and good faith of the agency, General Manager Genova has proposed that the first two weeks of G Line service be offered free of charge to passengers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the RTD Board of Directors expresses its full and unqualified support for and approval of the General Manager's proposal to offer free service for travel on the G Line for two weeks, commencing with the service day beginning Sunday, April 28, 2019, and ending Saturday, May 11, 2019, in order to demonstrate our strong support for our partnering communities and our abundant appreciation for the patience and perseverance of the district, particularly those constituents and businesses along the G Line corridor.
